International Seminar Youth in Action for Creating Inclusive Cities

The International Center for Research and Policy on Childhood in association with the Pontifical Catholic University of Rio de Janeiro (CIESPI/PUCRio), invites you to the International Seminar "Youth in Action for Creating Inclusive Cities".

The seminar is one of the outcomes of the project "Shaping Youth Futures: Livelihood Options in Creating Inclusive Cities", coordinated by Sukanya Krishnamurthy (University of Edinburgh, Scotland), with partners in Brazil (International Center for Research and Policy on Childhood - CIESPI/PUC-Rio) and India (Youth for Unity and Voluntary Action - YUVA, Fields of View - FoV and National Institute of Urban Affairs - NIUA). The aim of the project is to promote rights of young people through an exploration of youth livelihoods options, aligned with inclusive city aims, in India and Brazil. We achieve this through recognising young people as co-researchers and expert advisors within the project.

In Brazil, co-ordinated by Irene Rizzini, professor at the Department of Social Work at PUC-Rio, the CIESPI/PUC-Rio team has been working in partnership with the *Fórum Juventude Sul Fluminense em Ação* (Youth Forum of the South Fluminense in Action) and *Casa da Criança e do Adolescente* (Home of the Child and the Adolescent), located in the city of Volta Redonda/RJ.

The seminar will take place between May 30th to June 1st, 2022 at CIESPI and PUC-Rio. The objective is to share what has been learned and discuss the research results in Brazil and India.
